Summer 2018 Enrollment Program Information and Admission Requirements for Role Model Students

1. What is the Early College Experience (ECE) Summer 2018 enrollment program for Role Models in grades 3 through 8?

The Early College Experience is an academic partnership between the 5000 Role Models of Excellence Project and participating colleges/universities which enables eligible Role Model students in grades 3 through 8 to experience early college in the summer. The ECE summer 2018 enrollment program is taught by professors who have been vetted and approved by the 5000 Role Models office and the participating colleges/universities. Students and parents/legal guardians must be on track to complete program requirements and meet all necessary prerequisites for this program. Grades will not be awarded to participating students. Students who complete all required coursework receive a certificate of participation. **The length of the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program day stipulation:** The program will be approximately six weeks in length (last two weeks in June through the end of July) hours and days of the week are TBD. Parent meeting date is TBD.

2. What is the mission of the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program?

It is to provide an opportunity to:

- address skill gaps in at-risk male students and improve study skills and academic knowledge before becoming college students; and
- build a roadmap to college articulation and matriculation plans that will be used to guide secondary students to college and other academic post-secondary opportunities.

3. What are the goals of the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program?

- *A Positive Experience* – Strategies that will help at-risk male students to become more successful writers and learners.
- *Developing Self-Knowledge* – An emphasis on helping at-risk male students understand those characteristics of their learning styles that either impede or enhance their writing and learning.
- Developing at-risk male students’ confidence, motivation, and skills as writers.

4. What are the outcomes of the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program?

- To increase at-risk male students’ grade level promotion, high school graduation, college enrollment rates, college grade point average and progress toward college completion.
- To create an environment where at-risk male students feel validated.
- To help to develop at-risk male students both socially and academically for the demands of college expectations.

5. What is the primary objective of the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program?

It is to enhance each at-risk male student’s potential and foster positive interpersonal relationships. The ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program supports the concept that students who possess personal, academic, civic, academic and occupational adequacies will become effective and productive citizens. The following core values adopted by the School Board of Miami-Dade County Public Schools on July 26, 1995 will be reinforced throughout the duration the program:

a. Citizenship; b. Cooperation; c. Fairness; d. Integrity; e. Kindness; f. Pursuit of Excellence; g. Respect; h. Responsibility.

The 5000 Role Models office and participating college/university will communicate with parent/legal guardian when corrective strategies must be taken against the student.

6. Can a student be permanently removed from the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program?

Yes, the 5000 Role Models office and college/university staff may remove a student from the ECE summer 2018 enrollment program whose behavior the staff determines interferes with the professor’s ability to communicate effectively with the students in the class or with the ability of the student’s classmates to learn. *Students are expected to do their best!*

7. Does the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program provide transportation to the college campus?

No, parents will need to transport their child to the assigned college campus. There is no before/after school care program available. Parents must drop and pick up their child on time.

8. Does the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program provide lunch for the students participating in the program?

Yes, lunch will be provided by Miami-Dade County Public Schools Food and Nutrition Department. Microwaves are not available during this program.

9. Who pays the ECE Summer 2018 enrollment program tuition?

Students and parents/legal guardians are exempt from any fees. However, parents are responsible for program t-shirts.

10. Procedure to Apply:

Submit the reverse side of this form along with your child’s last report card and a letter of recommendation to the Site Director at the school **no later than Friday, October 20, 2017.**
